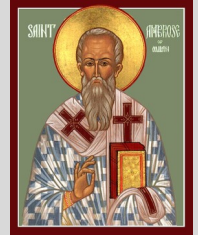

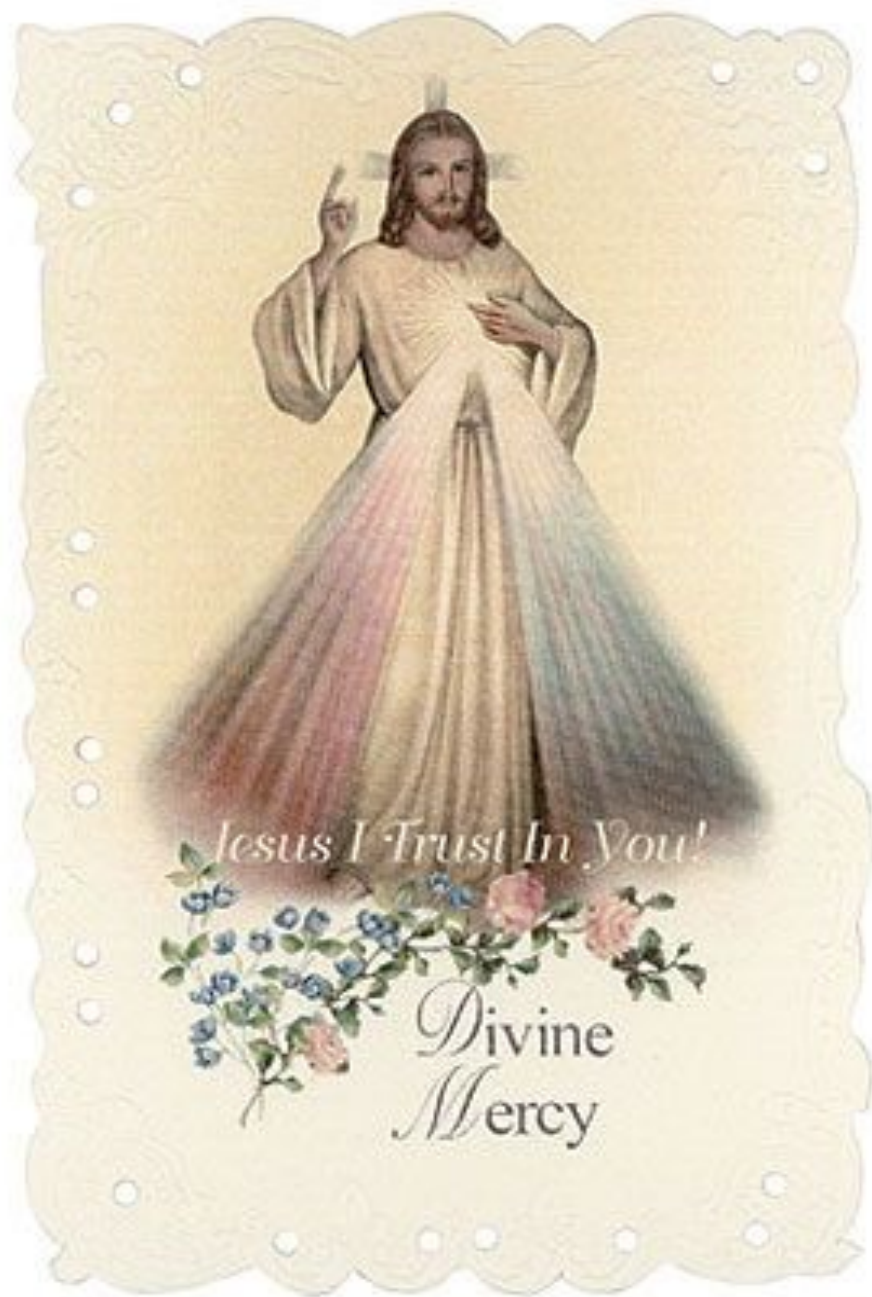
**Life is a Garden—Dig In!
